Requirements:

- Applicants must be 18 years of age.
- Possess a minimum of a high school diploma or national equivalent.
- Complete 40 hours of training (provided by Pathways Strategic Teaching Center within 90 days)
- Pass the RBT Competency Assessment throughout the 40 hours of training.
- Pass the RBT examination at the end of the 40 hours of training.
- Complete a criminal background check.
